Psalms 110:1-2 (NKJV) –[THE LORD said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.”

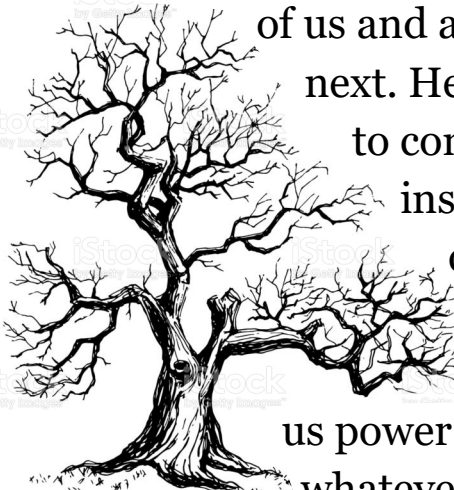
Father sent
